


Harnett Area Shag Association **FALL 2018 Newsletter**

PROPOSED BYLAWS CHANGES
Your HASA board recently proposed some changes in
our Bylaws, which will be addressed at an upcoming

open meeting to be held at one of our parties later this year.

**Proposed Amendment
HASA Bylaws**

NEW ARTICLE FIVE, SECTION 1

SECTION 1. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

A board of directors shall govern the Club. The board of directors shall include up to 10 directors, with five being elected as officers. The board of directors shall meet at least quarterly, with meetings called by the President. The board of directors shall be elected annually to serve a two year term at a meeting of the membership by a quorum of the membership. Each director shall hold office until his or her successor has been duly elected or appointed by the President, if a vacancy occurs.

REVISED ARTICLE FIVE, SECTION 2.

SECTION 2. ELECTION AND TERM OF OFFICERS

The Club officers shall be elected annually **by the board of directors to serve a one year term** from January through December. Each officer shall hold office until his **or her** successor has been duly elected, or appointed **by the President**, if a vacancy occurs

NEW ARTICLE SIX, SECTION 2.

SECTION 2. STANDING COMMITTEES

Standing Committees shall be appointed by the Executive Committee and will include the following committees:
