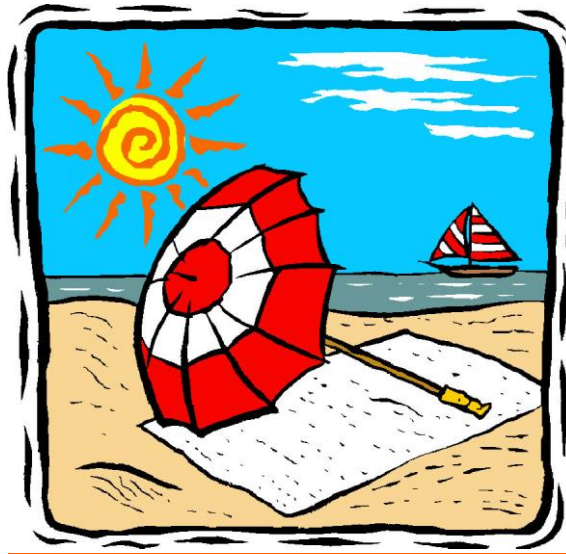

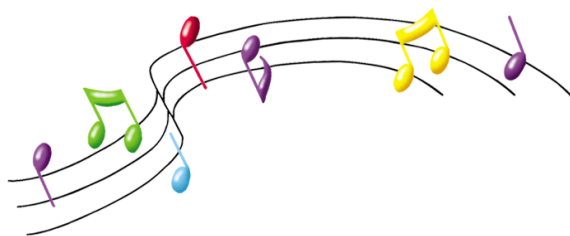


## **BOARD MEETING**

Jackson, Sergeant at Arms. The minutes were approved as was the Treasurer's report.
