DANCING MAKES YOU SMARTER

It's been scientifically proven that the only physical activity to offer protection against *dementia* is frequent dancing.

- · Reading 35% reduced risk of dementia
 - · Bicycling and swimming 0%
 - Doing crossword puzzles at least four days a week - 47%
 - · Playing golf 0%
 - Dancing frequently 76%.

"The purpose of the Club is to bring together a group of people who express an interest in shagging and the promotion of beach music."


